White Wine



Cepages VDP Sauvignon Blanc 187ml

Beautiful bright golden-yellow colour with the hints of blackcurrant, citrus fruit and tropical fruit. Sense of elegant, with floral and tropical fruit hint and a touch of beeswax. Round and fruity with a good balance and hint of acacia honey on the after taste.

Red Wine



Cepages VDP Merlot 187ml

This wine is an exclusive blend harvested in the Languedoc region. With its beautiful purple robe, this spicy wine with toasted notes sends out tantalising aromas of ripe fruit and prunes. This extremely vinous wine is well balanced.

White Wine



Cepages VDP Chardonnay Colombard 750ml

A dry white wine that reveals pleasant pineapple and fruit salad flavours, with some delightful citrus and charms of dried apple and musk. Well balanced with a quinsy, fresh zesty finish.



Baron De Vassal ,Sauvignon,Semillon et Ugni Blanc

This is the blend of the sauvignon, Semillon and Ugni blanc grape varieties.

This wine has a beautiful pale yellow colour with light green highlights. This nose is primarily floral and very elegant.

This soft, fresh and well balance wine is the perfect match for fish and seafood dishes. This wine is also perfect as an aperitif.

Should be served cooled.



Château Timberlay Sauvignon Semillon 2010

AOC Bordeaux

Sauvignon Blanc 50% and Semillon 50%

Is produced from 50% Sauvignon and 50% Semillon. This is an intense, attractive, pale yellow colour with hints of green. It has a distinguished and subtle floral bouquet. Well-balanced and full of character, this wine is crisp, yet soft. It is a very round and fruity on the palate with a touch of citrus.

Red Wine



Cepages VDP Merlot 750ml

This wine is an exclusive blend harvested in the Languedoc region. With its beautiful purple robe, this spicy wine with toasted notes sends out tantalising aromas of fruit and prunes. This extremely vinous wine is well balanced.



Baron De Vassal Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot

AOC Bordeaux

Cabernet Sauvignon 50% and Merlot 50%

This wine is very characteristic of its appellation. It is deep red, a distinguished concentrated nose predominated by red fruit (especially cherries). FULL BODIED round and smooth. This is a very balanced wine with quite an attractive fruity finish.



Baron De Vassal Grenache, Cinsault et Carignan

This wine is a result of a harmonious blend of Grenache, Cinsault and Carignan grape varieties.

This wine has a beautiful red colour with brilliant highlights, a fine and elegant nose with aromas of black fruits and sweet spices.

This wine is the perfect match for meat dishes, sauces and cheese. Should be served at room temperature.



Château Timberlay Bordeaux Superieur 2010

AOC Bordeaux Superieur

Merlot 80%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10% and Cabernet Franc 10%

This clear, bright wine is a superb ruby-red colour, with a complex nose of soft fruit (blackberry, blackcurrant and strawberry), and attractive woody and spicy overtones. Château TIMBERLAY is soft and full-bodied, with quite good structure and acidity as well as very elegant tannin. It is very long on the palate, with hints of vanilla and cinnamon.

Red Wine



Château Caroline 2008

AOC Moulis

Merlot 52%, Cabernet Sauvignon 46% and Petit Verdot 2%

This wine has a beautiful garnet bouquet and ruby red colour. The elegant bouquet has hints of vanilla and flowers such as violets and iris. When swirled in the glass, nuances of tropical fruit and humus comes through. This wine starts off very soft on the palate. It is well balanced and fruity with round tannins. The aftertaste is long and fruity with hints of caramel.



Château Timberlay Cuvée Prestige Rouge 2007

AOC Bordeaux Superieur

Cabernet Sauvignon 50% and Merlot 50%

This excellent wine has a deep colour and a fine elegant nose with Ripe fruit aromas. The bouquet is slightly toasty. It has a hint of spice & a touch of vanilla. It has a generous finish with extremely well integrated oak.

Château Moulin de Bel-Air 2011

Medoc Cru Bourgeois

Merlot 50% and Cabernet Sauvignon 50%

This wine is as typically Médoc as it is attractive. Its lovely colour is ruby tending towards garnet. Château Moulin de Bel-Air has a bouquet which is both delicate and concentrated with floral, and fruit aromas. Smooth and on the light side, though superbly well-balanced, this wine is quite long and soft.

Château Des Pèlerins 2011

AOC Pomerol

Merlot 80%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10% and Cabernet Franc 10%

This wine is a deep, bright, ruby colour, with straightforward, fairly intense fruity and floral bouquet reminiscent of vanilla and chocolate.

The wine starts off quite soft and develops beautifully on the palate. A round, fruity wine that goes into a fine, long, vanilla, aftertaste

Red Wine



Chateau Haut Chatain 2006

AOC Lalande de Pomerol

A spicy occasionally peppery, bouquet with hints of cherry jam. On the palate, ripe grape tannins blend with the tannin of the oak casks to produce a perfectly balanced wine. This wine is full and round, with hints of cocoa with good lengths in the mouth.

Chateau Lalande 2006

AOC Listra Medoc

Merlot 60%, Cabernet Sauvignon 30% and Petit Verdot 10%

This is a well-balanced wine & full bodied full bouquet, mellowness & Finesse. Chateau Lalande is located in the heart of the Haut-Medoc which produces a remarkable well-balanced wine that has won numerous awards. The wine is barrel-aged and one-third of all barrels are replaced annually.

Chateau Haut Milon 2008

AOC Pauillac

Merlot 50%, Cabernet Sauvignon 30% and Cabernet Franc 20%

The wines are elegant, supple and fruity. A beautiful robe reminiscent of crushed blackcurrants. It has a complex nose, with red fruits predominating, mainly blackcurrant and raspberry. When opening it is a powerful, rich, heady wine with soft, rounded tannins that will age wonderfully. The finish is fruity and tannic.



Château Laroque 2009

AOC Margaux

Cabernet Sauvignon 65%, Merlot 25%, Cabernet Franc 8% and Petit Verdot 2%

The nose is both intense and powerful with red fruits, vanilla and toasted aromas. This is a full bodied wine, with good balance and ripe tannins.

Chateau Cotes De Rol Grand Cru 2007

AOC St Emillon

Merlot 75%, Cabernet Franc 20% and Cabernet Sauvignon 5%

A deeply-coloured, full bodied and powerful without being aggressive. It has wonderful balance, a highly individual bouquet and flavour and good ageing potential as befits the greatest wine of Saint Emilion.
